

Jesus came into the world, not to condemn the world but to go and sin no more', so He also tells us to do the same. We need to turn away from our sin and allow Jesus to cleanse and heal our hearts. Like He told the woman 'to go and sin no more', so He also tells us to do the same.

11 She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more." John 8:3-11

7 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first." 8 And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. 9 Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. 10 When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?"

3 Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst, 4 they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act." 5 Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?" 6 This they said, testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear.

Jesus Forgave a woman caught in adultery:

Put your trust in Jesus and call upon His name.
He is not far from each one of us. If you seek
Him with all your heart you shall find Him.

How do I receive Jesus?

Receiving Jesus means that He wants you to invite Him to live inside of you. Jesus wants to live in you by His Spirit. There is a simple way of inviting Jesus to live in you. It involves three steps:

1. Saying, "I am sorry Jesus for the wrong things I have done against You and others, I want to change"
2. Saying, "Thank You for dying for me on the Cross and forgiving me of these wrong things I have done. I believe you love me and have forgiven me."
3. Saying, "Please come into my heart and life, live in me by Your Spirit and make Your home in me."

"voluntary sexual intercourse between a married man and someone other than his wife or between a married woman and someone other than her husband"

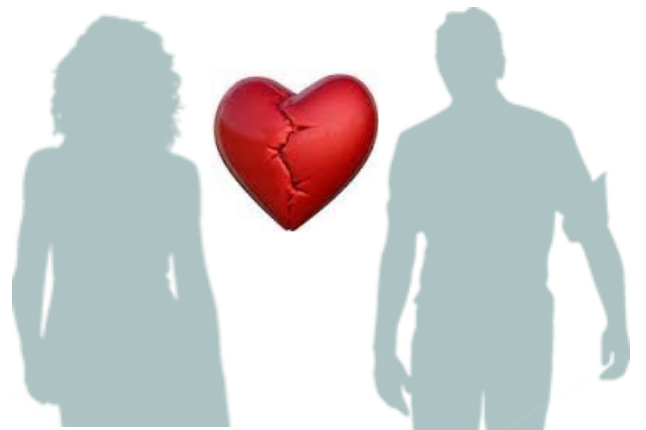
Webster's Definition of adultery:
