If we are to be made alive to God, we need to repent (turn from our evil ways) and put our faith in Jesus Christ and allow His blood to cleanse our hearts from all sin. (Acts 2:38, 1 John 1:7-9)

Through baptism we are raised in the power of Christ's resurrection, into newness of life
