

## Where does your Doctrine Come From?

There are many doctrines in the world that are anti-Christ. Many of these doctrines have a 'form of godliness' but they deny Jesus the Christ and lack any power.

**The Scriptures clearly warn us of these doctrines, they are called:**

- **The doctrines of men**  
(Colossians 2:22)
- **The doctrines of demons**  
(1 Timothy 4:1)
- **Various and strange doctrines**  
(Hebrews 13:9)
- **Every wind of doctrine**  
(Ephesians 4:14)
- **Doctrines of the Pharisees and Sadducees** (Matthew 16:12)

All these doctrines do not lead to life but rather to death. *'Wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it'*.  
(Matthew 7:13)

## There is only One Doctrine- the Doctrine is God!

*'In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God.....and the Word became flesh and dwelt among us and we beheld His glory, the glory of the only begotten of the Father full of grace and truth.'* (John 1:1,14)

### The Doctrine of God sets you free from sin

Romans 6:17-18, *'But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered...'*

We are to obey from the heart the doctrine of God. As we are obedient to His Word we will experience His cleansing in our hearts from all unrighteousness and sin.

**Come and let us return to the LORD. We must forsake all other doctrines. For He who does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God**

## The Doctrine of God is the Doctrine of Christ

2 John v9, *'Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son'*.

There is a full and complete revelation of God through receiving and believing the doctrine of Christ. Through Christ you come to know the Father in the Son.

**If you have this doctrine you have God!**

## The Doctrine of God makes known the mystery of godliness: God manifested in the flesh! (1 Tim 3:16)

1 Timothy 6:3-4a, *'If anyone teaches otherwise and does not consent to wholesome words, the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which accords with godliness, he is proud, knowing nothing.'*

**The doctrine of God not only reveals the words of Christ but reveals the very person of Christ**

## The Doctrine of God is the Apostles' Doctrine: The Words that Jesus gave to them! (John 17:8)

Acts 2:42, *'And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine....'*

We are not only to believe in this doctrine but also continue in it steadfastly

## The Doctrine of God releases the authority of God

Mark 1:27, *'Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves saying, "what is this? What new doctrine is this? For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him"*

This doctrine does not come from man nor through man but through the revelation of Jesus the Christ. (Gal 1:12)

## The Doctrine of God is Sound doctrine

2 Timothy 4:3, *'For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers'*.

**Sound doctrine is that which exalts the truth of God's word alone. It does not contain any mixture of man's doctrine.**

## The Doctrine of God is to fill every place!

Acts 5:28, *'Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine.....'*

God has always intended the earth to be filled with knowledge of the glory of God (Habakkuk 2:14)

How can this happen? By teaching and preaching this doctrine!

## The Doctrine of God is preaching and teaching Jesus as the Christ!

Acts 5:42, *'Daily in the temple and in every house they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ'*.
