



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

As we communicate with Him we grow to know Him better.



- (b) We spend time on our own thinking about God






(c) We ask Him questions.





(a) Write a letter to God and call Him "Father". Tell Him you are glad He is your Father. Ask Him to talk to you about heaven.



HONOURING GOD'S NAME

Do you know that many names have a special meaning?



God has many names and each name reveals something about His character. His names tell us what He is like.

At first He told Moses His name was (Exodus 3:14)


The people called Him Jehovah.

Then as they got to know God, He showed them what He was like. Read the Scriptures given to see some of the ways He showed Himself to the people:

I AM JEHOVAH JIREH


THE LORD MY RIGHTEOUSNESS - God saved His people. He sent JESUS to make us right with God. JESUS' name means




Every day he led the people to be more like Himself. He called His people to be separate from sin in the world.

Teachers, Parents and Children,

Please note that JEHOVAH is not an accurate translation of the name of the LORD from the Old Testament Hebrew. This form of His Name has been popularised.

In more recent times, YAHWEH has been used as the transliteration of His Name. This is more closely derived from the 4 consonants, YHWH, which is apparently how the Name appears in the original text (ie. four Hebrew consonants). The Jewish believers of Old Testament days never spoke the Name but referred to the LORD by the name ADONAI, which means Lord or Master.

In most English Bibles, the Name of the LORD, appears as LORD, that is, the four letters are all rendered in upper case or as capital letters. When the title ADONAI is translated into English, it is written as Lord, ie. 1 upper case, then 3 lower case letters.

We bring this to your attention, for information sake, but also, for reason of sensitivity and respect for Jewish believers, and in a desire to hear from God in this important issue of "What is His Name?"

Jesus told us to pray for God's kingdom to come and for God to rule here on earth just as He rules in heaven. (Matthew 6:10)


We've already looked at His names and they've told us what kind of king God is.

What do I pray for?


The Bible says the Kingdom of God is WITHIN us. (Luke 17:21)

The Bible says that in God's kingdom, there is peace and joy and everyone is right with God. (Romans 14:17).


God rules with justice. (Isaiah 30:18)

God wants all men to be saved and to be in His kingdom.




HOW DO I RECEIVE THE ANSWERS?


Jesus told us to ask God for our daily bread.

Jesus said, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God."








God wants to speak to us. He has a plan for each of our lives; (Remember Jeremiah 29:11?) and He wants us to know this plan.

(2 Timothy 3:16)




How do I receive the answers?

(b) Jesus promised the Holy Spirit would tell us His plans.(John 16: 13 and 15)

How does the Holy Spirit tell us?

Sometimes we hear God speak into our minds.



(c) God promised He would show us pictures. These are called dreams and visions.

"And afterwards, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions." Joel 2:28

This happened to some men on the day of Pentecost. (Acts 2:17-18)




Peter reminded the people that this promise is for us and for our children and for all whom God calls. (Acts 2:39)

How do I receive the answers?

God WANTS to talk with us and show us His will here on earth. He has promised that His Spirit will do this for us.

ACTIVITY

Have the children stand in a receptive position (e.g. with hands held out cupped to receive).

Encourage them to think about Jesus.

Ask the Lord to give the children a vision, or a picture, or to talk to them.

Wait on the Lord, expecting Him to answer.

Then encourage the children to write down or draw what God is showing.

Share what God has shown - allowing the children to describe or interpret what they have recorded.

OOPS! I'VE DONE IT AGAIN - BUT GOD FORGIVES



We often do or think things that we know are wrong. We bring punishment on ourselves and this makes us sad.





But the worst thing is that we've made God sad. What we do wrong has put a barrier between us and God.



But God loves us so much He's made a way for us to be right again. (John 14:6)

He has sent Jesus who took all our punishment when He died on the cross.







Jesus tells us to FORGIVE.




HELP! LOOKS GOOD ... BUT GOD'S POWER IS MIGHTY TO SAVE!

SHILOH SCHOOL OF MINISTRY

is based at the SHILOH Centre in Toowoomba but can travel anywhere.

<u>Short Term Training Schools</u> [2 weeks in duration] are held at least twice yearly, at SHILOH Centre. The short term training provides a means for many saints to be equipped and released into fruitful ministry. Schools are held in other centres on request.

<u>Apostolic/Prophetic conferences</u> hosted every few months with recognized apostles and prophets ministering.

Monthly Training Days held on Saturdays 10am to 5pm. Teaching the apostles doctrine. Occasional guest ministries to teach and train.

Leadership gatherings held on Fridays prior to Monthly Training Day.

Weekly Teaching Sessions to open up the scriptures, bringing revelation with line upon line teaching of the Word.

<u>Discipleship Courses</u> to encourage new believers to become full on disciples, through reading scripture, recording what the Lord is saying, memorising verses, praying for the lost and witnessing to their faith.

<u>Bible Research Classes</u> teaching use of concordances, message preparation, preaching and teaching practice.
